On April 11, 2006 the Wooster High School Marching Band and Orchestra will pack into four charter buses and begin a five-day trip to Boston, Massachusetts.

The itinerary includes many exciting cultural opportunities. Still being finalized, the schedule includes such activities as, a visit to the USS Constitution (*Old Ironsides*); the Boston Museum of Fine Arts; a dinner cruise in Boston Harbor; an open dress rehearsal of the Boston Symphony Orchestra as they perform the Berlioz *Requiem*; a visit to the Prudential Center Skywalk for a view of the city; a *Duck Tour* aboard an amphibious vehicle; a guided tour of Fenway Park, the home of the Boston Red Sox; dinner at TV's famous *Cheers* restaurant; a guided walking tour of the Freedom Trail; and time spent at Quincy Market including an outdoor performance from the band and orchestra students. soon if we will get a chance to perform at Fenway Park. The itinerary will be finalized once this last piece is in place.
