Concert Choir Prepares for Pittsburgh Trip

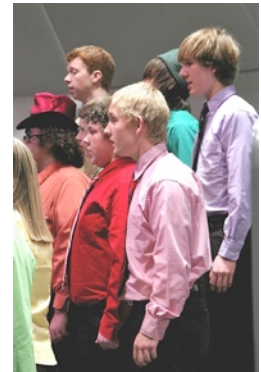
