Our Fiscal Responsibilities...

Operation and support of the WHS music program over the years has been a team effort... the school, the staff, the parents association, and of course the students.

Through this team effort many of the pieces needed to make this an ongoing successful program have been put in place. When the marching band purchased new uniforms in 1991, the parents association knew they would one day have to be replaced and started setting aside a portion of our fundraising efforts in a uniform replacement fund. The students and our volunteers have done an outstanding job of maintaining and caring for our current uniforms. As a result of good stewardship and fundraising, the music parents association now has enough funds saved to replace the uniforms. The instruments, however, need to be replaced.

Why we need your help to continue the tradition...

- Larger, more expensive instruments are not purchased by students/parents. They are used year after year and stay at the school.
- These include items such as Sousaphones, Tubas, Euphoniums, Tenor Saxes, Bari Saxes, Bass Clarinets, Bassoons, virtually all Percussion, and the choirs' Grand Piano.
- Through constant care and a commitment to repair, we have made many of our instruments useful for generations of music students.
- Many of these instruments were purchased over 40 years ago (during the Nixon administration...).
- Instruments can be repaired and restored only so many times before they must be replaced.

Our Goal is to jump start a permanent instrument replacement fund that would then be sustained through our own fundraising efforts, much like the uniform fund has done over the years. Over the next three years we will build a fund to fill this need.
